

### ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

### BETWEEN

## MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY

### AND

### LEHIGH CARBON COMMUNITY COLLEGE

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 17th day of January 2024, by Marywood University ("Marywood"), a nonprofit, 501 (c) 3, religious and educational organization with offices in Scranton, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania, and Lehigh Carbon Community College ("Lehigh Carbon") 4525 Education Park Drive, Schnecksville, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania 18078, herein known as the "Parties" or "Party."

WHEREAS, Marywood University ("Marywood") is a 501(c)3, nonprofit, religious and educational organization with offices in Scranton, Pennsylvania;

WHEREAS, Lehigh Carbon and Marywood agree to correlate their curricula for students enrolled in the Associate in Applied Science in Professional Pilot Program at Lehigh Carbon who wish to earn a Bachelor of Business Administration in Aviation Management (Professional Pilot/Flight Operations Track) at Marywood University.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, Marywood University and Lehigh Carbon agree as follows:

# I. Responsibilities of Marywood

- A. Marywood will grant admission to a student who has satisfactorily completed the requirements of the AAS degree in Professional Pilot at Lehigh Carbon with a 2.5 grade point average or above.
- B. Marywood will accept for transfer credits which a student earns with a grade of 'C' or better, based on the articulation agreement equivalency Transfer Guide, attached hereto, marked as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference thereto, provided the student meets all terms and conditions outlined in this Articulation Agreement.
- C. The Transfer Guide is based on the Lehigh-Carbon curriculum and explains how Marywood will accept the Lehigh Carbon courses for transfer credit.
- D. Marywood requires a minimum of 120 credits to receive an undergraduate degree in Aviation Management.

- E. Transfer students must complete a minimum of 42 credits at Marywood.
- F. A student must maintain a 2.33 GPA in their major and a 2.0 overall GPA in order to earn a degree from Marywood
- G. This Articulation Agreement is only a guide. Marywood cannot guarantee that the courses required to complete the Bachelor of Business Administration: Aviation Management (Professional Pilot/Flight Operations Track) will be offered in a given semester.
- H. Marywood estimates that a student can earn a Bachelor of Business Administration in Aviation Management (Professional Pilot/Flight Operations Track) in two years, a minimum of four semesters, provided the student strictly complies with all aspects of this Articulation Agreement.
- I. Marywood will offer scholarship opportunities to Lehigh Carbon students based upon existing scholarship opportunities for transfer students.

# II. Responsibilities of Lehigh Carbon

- A. The student must meet all deadline dates for application to the University, pay all fees, and meet any other deadlines applicable to new students at Marywood.
- B. Marywood will waive the application fee for eligible students.
- C. To be eligible to transfer to Marywood, the student cannot attend another institution of higher education between graduating from Lehigh Carbon Community College and enrolling at Marywood University.
- D. Provide appropriate marketing collateral to distribute to their qualified students.
- E. Include details of this Articulation Agreement:
  - a) on their website and on all pages related to their Associate in Applied Science in Professional Pilot Program;
  - b) In Marywood undergraduate marketing materials; and
  - c) In student discussions with Pre-Professional Advisors

# III. Transfer to Marywood

- A. Should a student be unable to meet all of the terms and conditions outlined herein, Marywood University will determine the student's appropriate number of transfer credits on an individual basis.
- B. Students who wish to transfer to Marywood University prior to earning an Associate's degree from Lehigh Carbon Community College must submit their official transcript for a course-by-course evaluation.

## IV. Term and Termination

This agreement has been entered into in Scranton, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania. It shall be effective as of and shall continue through June 30, 2029. The Parties have the right to terminate this Agreement by providing the other Party with thirty (30) days' notice. In the event that Marywood or Lehigh Carbon terminate this Agreement, they agree to make reasonable efforts and cooperate to enable students enrolled in the Associate Degree program in Professional Pilot at Lehigh Carbon Community College or the Bachelor of Business Administration program in Aviation Management at Marywood University to complete their degree at Marywood.

### V. Indemnification

- A. Marywood hereby indemnifies and holds Lehigh Carbon, its employees and agents, harmless from and against liability, losses, damages, claims, causes of action, costs, or expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) which directly arise out of the negligence or intentional acts or omissions of Marywood, its trustees, students, employees, or agents.
- B. Lehigh Carbon hereby indemnifies and holds Marywood, its trustees, students, employees, or agents, harmless from and against liability, losses, damages, claims, causes of action, costs, or expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) which directly arise out of the negligence or intentional acts or omissions of Lehigh Carbon, its employees or agents.

### VI. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A. Entire Agreement: This agreement constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties regarding the subject matter hereof and supersedes and replaces all prior understandings or agreements of the parties, whether oral or written, with respect to this matter. This agreement prohibits amendments, modifications, or alterations without the express written agreement of both parties.
- B. Anti-Terrorism: Marywood and Facility represent that neither is listed on any watch lists designated by U.S. Treasury Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) and that neither provides financial or material support to any individual or organization on such list.
- C. Successors and Assigns: This agreement shall be binding on the parties and their respective successors and assigns. Neither party shall assign this agreement without the prior written consent of the other party.
- D. Effect of Invalidity or Unenforceability: If for any reason any provision of this agreement will be determined to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the validity and effect of the other provisions will not be affected.
- E. Non-Waiver of Breach: The waiver by Marywood or Lehigh Carbon of a breach of any provision of this agreement by the other party will not operate, or be construed, as a waiver of any breach of any other provision of this agreement.

- F. No Third-Party Rights: This agreement is between Marywood and Lehigh Carbon and Healing only. No other party shall have any enforceable rights under this agreement.
- G. Non-Discrimination: The parties agree not to unlawfully discriminate against any person on the basis of race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, religion, age, disability, veteran's status, national origin or any other basis prohibited by law.
- H. Governing Law: This agreement shall be governed, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Any dispute arising from this agreement shall be instituted only in the Court of Common Pleas of Lackawanna County.

All notices between the Parties shall be in writing, signed by the party forwarding the notice and delivered in person, by certified mail, return receipt requested, and/or by reputable overnight delivery, and addressed as follows:
